

SHORT NOTICE

Applications are invited from the manufacturers of Drip/ Micro/ Sprinkler Irrigation System for registration to install the system on horticulture/non horticulture and other crops on the fields of farmers in the State of Punjab for the year 2011-12, 2012-13 and 2013-14. Applicant firm should be a manufacturer of HDPE pipes (IS:14151 pt II/99) and Rotating Sprinklers (IS:12232/95) in case of sprinkler (subject to DAC-GOI/SMIC relaxation for IS:12232) and of lateral IS:12786/89), emitting devices (other than micro tubes) in case of Drip confirming to BIS standards. The applications should reach in this office up to 10-03-2011 along with documents. The detail of required documents can be taken from the office of the Chief Conservator of Soils, Punjab, on any working day.

DETAIL OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTS/ TERMS AND CONDITIONS
FOR ENLISTMENT OF DRIP/SPRINKLER IRRIGATION FIRMS FOR THE
YEAR 2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14

- 1) For Drip Irrigation the company must manufacture at least lateral and emitting devices (other than micro-tubes) conforming to BIS standards and for Sprinkler Irrigation the company should manufacture at least the HDPE pipes and nozzles as per BIS specifications. They must provide guarantee of quality assurance of other components which is not manufactured by them.
- 2) The company will supply the BIS marked material only. The attested photo copies of valid BIS certificate should be sent. The list of relevant BIS components is given in Annexure "A".
- 3) In case, the company intends to supply imported components, they should have prior approval of the DAC.
- 4) List of component wise prices should be submitted.
- 5) The undertaking to provide free after sales service to the farmers at least for three years and detail of network and infrastructure with their regional office, service centre at the state/Division/District level should be submitted on stamp paper.
- 6) The firms selected for enlistment will have to give bank guarantee worth Rs.2.00 lac which will be released after successful performance during three years.
- 7) The maintenance manual also be provided at the time of registration to this office as well as to the farmers at the time of installation.
- 8) A draft of Rs.50,000/- as non refundable registration fee should be submitted in favour of Chief Conservator of Soils, Punjab, Chandigarh for the year 2011-12 and Rs.25,000/- non refundable registration fee will be charged every year from the system manufacturer.
- 9) The manufacturer shall take the responsibility in case of any dispute arising from the supply of their product through their distributor or dealer. In all cases the manufacturer should authenticate the invoices and should be signed by their representatives.
- 10) Departmental permission is mandatory if the system is supplied through authorized distributor/ dealer.
- 11) Manufacturer must have qualified engineers for estimation, technical guidance to the farmers and list of technical staff, service centre along with complete address, mobile number, E-mail ID should be produced at the time of registration.
- 12) All disputes or differences shall be referred for arbitration to the Chief Conservator of Soils, Punjab, whose decision shall be final and binding on all the parties within 6 months on the date of payment of final bill. If the matter is not referred for arbitration within the specified period, all the rights and claims under the contract shall be deemed to have been forfeited and absolutely barred.
- 13) All disputes will be settled within the jurisdiction of courts at Chandigarh.
